



Church on the Lawn FAQ

1. Q: What times will Sunday Services be held?
A: 9 am
2. Q: How long will service last?
A: Our simple, abbreviated service will last 45 minutes.
3. Q: Where do I go when I arrive at church?
A: You'll be directed where to park, depending on whether you want to sit on the lawn or attend from your car.
4. Q: Can I choose my spot on the lawn?
A: Yes. Please be mindful to keep 6 feet of distance between family, roommate, or small Life Group units and take care not to block others' view of the stage with canopies or umbrellas.
5. Q: Do I have to wear a mask?
A: You are welcome to wear a mask, but it is not required outside. A mask *is* required to go inside to the restroom.
6. Q: Will there be Kids Ministry?
A: For everyone's safety, we have decided to wait to reopen Kids Ministry. Activity packets will be available for kids to complete while sitting with their families.
7. Q: Are restrooms open?
A: Yes, but masks are required to enter the building and because of limited space, restrooms will be monitored, allowing only one person at a time. We encourage you to use the restroom before you come.
8. Q: Can I come if I'm 60+ or immune compromised?
A: Please make a decision that feels right for you. We are offering two other options in addition to sitting on the lawn: you may stay in your car and participate in the service through your FM speaker, or watch the livestream or recording from home.
9. Q: Will coffee be provided?
A: In order to minimize the number of shared surfaces touched, coffee will *not* be provided. Feel free to bring your own.
10. Q: What should I bring to outdoor Sunday Service?
A: A lawn chair or blanket to sit on and a heart ready to worship God and meet people where they're at in their journey with this crisis.
